



## **AMENDMENT NO.1 TO THE NOTICE OF RACE: HEALTH GUIDELINES**

The health context, recommendations by the FFVoile and the prescriptions set out by the prefectural authorities have prompted us to take the following measures:

### 1. Arrangements on shore.

- Officially registered skippers and their teams or those accompanying them shall present a negative result to a PCR test less than 72 hours before their arrival on site from Wednesday 26 May at 14:00hrs; a register will have to be signed in exchange for a name badge, which shall be worn at all times.
- Members of the organization team, referees and all providers shall present a negative result to a PCR test less than 72 hours before their arrival on site; a register will have to be signed in exchange for a name badge, which shall be worn at all times.
- The organisation's offices and reception areas dedicated to the skippers can only be accessed by those people who are duly registered and have met the requirements set out above.
- Mask wearing is compulsory at all times across the entire event site in Caen and Ouistreham, whether it be at the general public village at Quai Vendeuvre, the reception areas at Quai François Mitterrand, the organisation's offices at the Pavillon or the Ouistreham port area.
- Groups of more than 6 people, public, racers and organisation, shall be avoided when social distancing (2 m) cannot be respected.
- Hand sanitiser gel will be available at the entrances to the general public villages, the Carré des Skippers (skippers' area) and the organisation's offices at the Pavillon.
- The usual social events organised around the race (press conference, presentation of the skippers, skippers' dinner) have been cancelled with the exception of the final prize-giving, which will take place at the Carré des Skippers with reduced numbers and will be outdoors, weather permitting.
- The start briefing on Saturday 29 May at 10:00hrs will be organised via video conference.

### 2. Measures aboard the boats both dockside and at sea.

- Skippers and preparateur assistants aboard the Class40s dockside will be able to work on their boats without wearing a mask provided that no more than 2 persons are aboard at the same time and have presented a negative PCR test.
- When following the start on Sunday 30 May, guests aboard the accompanying launches shall wear a mask throughout the duration of the operation.
- Skippers will have to fill out a medical self-assessment questionnaire on the morning of the start on Sunday 30 May and return it to Race Management.



- Mask wearing is not compulsory for the skippers at sea throughout the official duration of the race.
- The presence aboard of COVID-19 symptoms during the race shall immediately be reported by the skipper to Race Management, who will decide on the appropriate action following medical advice, which may lead to their withdrawal from the race.
- Competitors and those accompanying them shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official.
- Failure to comply with these measures may constitute misconduct and may be the subject of a report drawn up by the Organising Authority and / or Race Management with the International Jury. [DP]
- Reasonable action taken by those in charge of the Organising Authority and / or Race Management for the event in order to implement the various COVID-19 directives, protocols or legislation, even if they subsequently prove to be unnecessary, are not inadequate actions or omissions and shall not give rise to a request for redress (this is a change to the RRS 62.1(a)).

### 3. COVID reference

- The COVID reference on shore will be the safety officer, Mr Joël Mutrel (+33 (0)6 51 25 50 92; [joel.mutrel@orange.fr](mailto:joel.mutrel@orange.fr)). He shall be immediately informed of the presence at the event of a person with suspected COVID symptoms.
